I have never really understood why so many people knockWhispering Angel Rosé. This pioneering winery raises the bar every year and this newly released 2023 is sensational. Already open and alluring, '23 is a precocious vintage which (for once) will hit its peak this summer and no doubt hold for a year or two after. Rose petals, rhubarb and pomegranate lead the perfume and a sensual and succulent palate follows, topped with teasing, palate-pinching acidity. Don't knock it until you have tasted it.

A silky, seductive and saline Côtes de Provence rosé with aromas of small berries, red currants and salt. It's medium-bodied, succulent, fresh and playful, with a caressing texture and a vivid, saline finish. Drink now.

Whispering Angel is a classic choice for rosé lovers. Made from a combination of grenache, cinsault and rolle grapes, this pale pink wine is an easy-to-drink wine that is smooth and simple. Despite having a pretty luscious palate, it is incredibly dry. The floral and fruity aroma showcases lavender, clove and cherry notes, while the palate holds hints of spicy minerality that lead into a smooth and round finish. Sip the alongside grilled salmon or a goat cheese salad.
